COCO 3 Compatibility

Through good software and hardware engineering, and a little luck, <u>all</u> Speech Systems products are compatible without modification with the new Tandy COCO 3 except as noted below.

EARS (Disk System)

- 1. Turn computer on.
- 2. EXEC &HE010
- 3. EXEC &H8002

EARS (Tape System)

- 1. Turn computer on.
- 2. EXEC &H8C2E

now continue as indicated in the manual, for example LOADM "EARS"

COCO MIDI II, Casio Librarian, & DX Librarian
The following steps are necessary only if you use a Radio Shack
MULTI-PAK. Skip these if you use a "Y" cable.

- 1. Your disk controller <u>must</u> be in slot 4.
- 2. COCO MIDI $\underline{\text{must}}$ be in slot 3.
- 3. Turn on the computer.
- 4. POKE 65407,51: EXEC 57360 (This must be on 1 line) now continue as indicated in the manual
- 5. LOADM "COCOMIDI" or one of the librarians
- 6. etc.

SUPER VOICE

The SUPER VOICE requires both a hardware and software modification to work with the COCO 3. If you purchased your unit before February 1987 you have a COCO 1 & 2 version only. The COCO 3 version is indicated by a RED label on both the disk and the ROM PAK box.

Those wishing to upgrade, may return their SUPER VOICE hardware cartridge with \$20 plus P&H \$3 after the end of February. The price includes hardware modification and new software.
