

## TuneUp FAQ (Frequently Answered Questions)

### 1. What is TuneUp?

TuneUp is a set of replacement modules for stock OS-9. It runs on any stock Coco, no modifications are needed.

### 2. What does TuneUp do for me?

TuneUp re-writes and optimizes the OS-9 modules that it replaces. The main result is to allow 19200 baud serial I/O on an unmodified Coco.

Other optimizations are planned for the future.

TuneUp is currently in alpha test, and will be shipping sometime after the 1994 Atlanta Fest.

### 4. Should I get TuneUp instead of NitroS-9?

Certainly not!

TuneUp is an attempt to keep die-hard 6809 people happy. It offers minor improvements to stock OS-9, where NitroS-9 offers major improvements.

In terms of visible speed, there is simply no comparison. NitroS-9 greatly outperforms TuneUp. Even the PowerBoost patches will have your computer running much faster than TuneUp.

### 5. Is TuneUp compatible with PowerBoost?

No. And it will never be.

After the release of TuneUp, the only people who will not be able to run 19.2k baud connections on their Coco are people who insist on running PowerBoost.
