The Database by John Mark Mobley

Bob Swoger is maintaining a database for the club. He is looking for someone that will pick it up and learn it. It is written in Microsoft QBASIC and Microsoft DOS batch files. It generates reports, a string of email addresses, and web pages. It can be used for registering people at the CoCoFEST! If you have an interest in databases and want to help out, then let Bob know. Because the database contains personal data, access to the database will require club approval. Bob's health is declining and he would like to teach you his system. You will likely be tempted to convert his system over to something newer, but you will still need to learn his system. It is quite involved and ties into many aspects of the club. If you do convert the system, then Bob would like a way to save the data in the new and old format so that his system will continue to work for some time to come.

When registering people at the CoCoFEST! we like to have two screens so the database operator and the person checking in can see and verify the data. This has been done from a CoCo 3 using the composite and RGB outputs. It is nice to see the CoCo being used for productivity. Then the data has to be converted back into Bob's system on an IBM PC.

I would like the database to run on a server so that multiple people can access it through the internet. The club could get a virtual private server for about \$1.00 a month and we would require a user name and password. Perhaps each member could update his own information using a CoCo as a terminal. What if it

would only work from a CoCo terminal for added security?

I have learned the system and can be of some assistance. But it would be best to talk to Bob while he is still able. If you are willing to call or Skype Bob daily or weekly then he can help you.

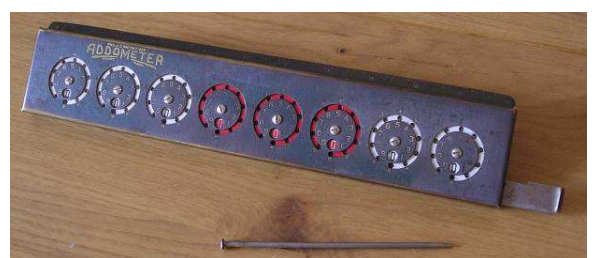

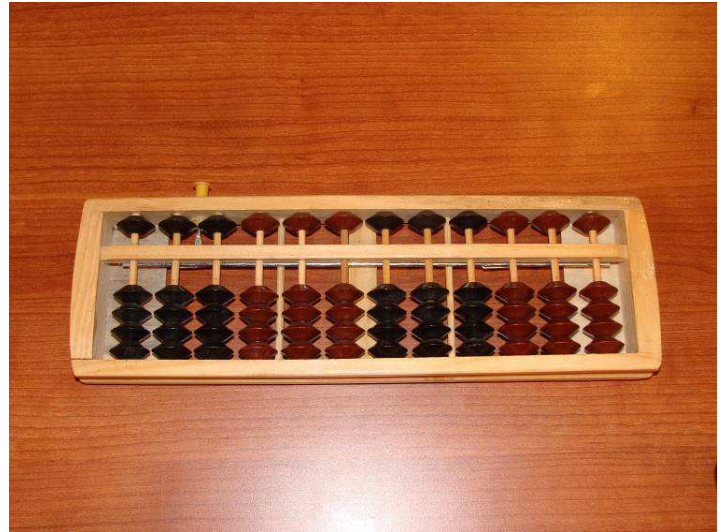

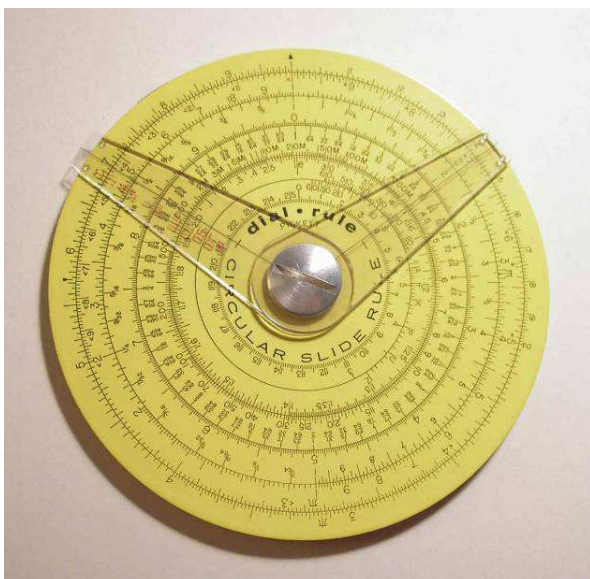

How to prepare for the CoCoFEST!

Q) How do I reserve some booth space?

A) EMAIL Tony Podraza with a filled out contract obtained from:

http://www.glensideccc.com/data/library/cocofest_exhibit/contract-2017.doc

Q) How do I reserve time to give a presentation?

A) Contact John Linville. He can be reached at:

<http://www.glensideccc.com/contact/index.shtml>

Q) What should I bring?

A1) Musical instruments.

A2) We hold two auctions, so bring stuff you want to keep out of landfills to go into the auctions, and bring some spending money to spend on auction items to add to your collection that you didn't have a chance to purchase when you were younger. The money from the auctions goes to help pay for the CoCoFEST! Buy books, manuals, software, cables, joysticks, disk drives, computers, fanfold paper, and such. If you bring an item and it does not sell, then consider taking it back home with you. Printers generally do not sell and no one wants to be stuck with it.

A3) People are selling hardware and software (outside of the auction) so bring some spending money for that.

A4) Charge the battery in your camera and bring it.

A5) Bring hardware you want repaired or upgraded.

A6) If you have a booth, then bring extension cords, power strips, and tape to hold them down.

A7) Bring your ideas.

A8) Chicago has toll roads so bring some change to drop in the tollbooth change acceptor basket. Lots of change to pay for the toll road charges.

Q) Is Wi-Fi available to all at the CoCoFEST?

A) Yes!

Q) What kind of computer should I bring to show?

A1) CoCos, Tandy, TRS-80, Radio Shack, and clones.

A2) Anything that runs a Motorola 6809, Hitachi 6309, Motorola 68k, Zilog Z80, Intel 8080, Intel 8008, Intel 4004

A3) Southwest Technical Products Corp. (SWTPC)

A4) Tomcat, MM/1, AT306, Delmar System IV/ Peripheral Technology PT68K-4

A5) FPGA, Microprocessor, Arduino, Raspberry Pi and such.

A6) Calculator, adding machine, slide rule, and abacus.

A7) Analog computer

A8) Mechanical computers

Q) Would people want to see NitrOS-9/6809 driving a teletype machine, teleprinter, paper terminal or silent 700?

A) Yes!

Q) Would people like to see a plain old telephone bulletin board system in operation using 300 baud?

A) Yes!

Q) Can I arrange for my booth to be next to someone else?

A) Tony Podraza has traditionally arranged the booths. Make your desire known on your contract.

Q) What is the attendance like?

A) 50 to 100 people are likely to attend and 95% of them are male.

Q) Will there be an opportunity for non-vendors to swap/trade/sell hardware?

A) The entire event consists of trading, swapping, buying and selling software, hardware, other stuff, stories, anecdotes and knowledge. I think you would be hard pressed to not find time to do this.

Q) How do I get a table?

A1) Fill out the Exhibiter's form and request a table. These tables are in a room secured overnight. The Exhibiter's form is available for download from the club's website.

A2) Tables can be set up in the hallway, but these tables cannot be secured overnight. These tables are good if you just need a place to sit down and rest your feet and also good for someone who is just staying for one day. They are good for displaying a demo. These tables are good for setting up a small system than can be quickly set up and taken down. You can bring your own table if you like and set it in the hallway. These tables are good for setting up a free pile of stuff for people to take. This would most likely be for stuff not suitable for the auction.

A3) There are tables in the lunch room. This may be a good spot to hold a small meeting or discussion. You can also sit down and set up a laptop or tablet computer and check your email.

Q) How do I get from the airport to the hotel?

A1) You can take a rental car, taxi, Uber, or limo.

A2) If by taxi, I would recommend American Taxi (AT).

Q) What should I wear?

A1) A Hawaiian shirt and blue jeans would be fine.

A2) A CoCoFEST shirt and wash pants are also fine.

Q) How do I know I am getting a good room rate at the hotel?

A) We have a special overnight room rate at the Fairfield Inn of \$92 plus 11% total \$102.12. You must phone 630-629-1500 and mention Glenside CoCoFEST! to get this special rate.

Q) When should I arrive?

A) Get there before dark on Friday. Sunset is 7:40 PM.

Q) When can I set up my booth/table?

A) It may be possible for a few people to set up on Friday evening between 6:00-9:00 PM. Otherwise you can set up on Saturday morning between 7:00-9:00 AM.

Q) What are my options for gluten free food?

A) Jimmy John's sells a lettuce wrap just across the street. Our catered dinner also has a gluten free selection.

Q) How do you know how many people are coming to the catered dinner?

A) We rely on people to write Tony Podraza and make reservations. See the Contact Us portion of our website.

Q) Is the CoCoFEST! in a high crime area?

A) No! Absolutely not!

Q) Is this a busy area?

A) Busy is a relative term. Downtown Chicago is very busy. Lombard is half or a third as busy. And parking is free.

Q) How is the building laid out?

A) If you start at the Fairfield Inn & Suites, you can walk across the parking lot to the Heron Point Building / Convention Center. Then walk into the lobby on the 1st floor and take the stairs or the elevator to the Basement/Lower Level. Next you will find a circular hallway around the lunchroom and several rooms on the periphery. One room is for registering, presentations, and the auction (Room C). Another room is for exhibitor tables/booths (Rooms A & B). Rooms A & B are connected with a divider that can be set in the middle. And the hallway may have tables also. Rooms A & B together are 61 x 36 x 9 ft. Room C is 55 x 32 x 9 ft. There are also vending machines, a water fountain, and restrooms.

Q) Can I get around the building on a scooter?

A) Yes! Just ride into the elevator and go from there.

Q) What if I have more questions?

A) Go to the Contact Us portion of our website.

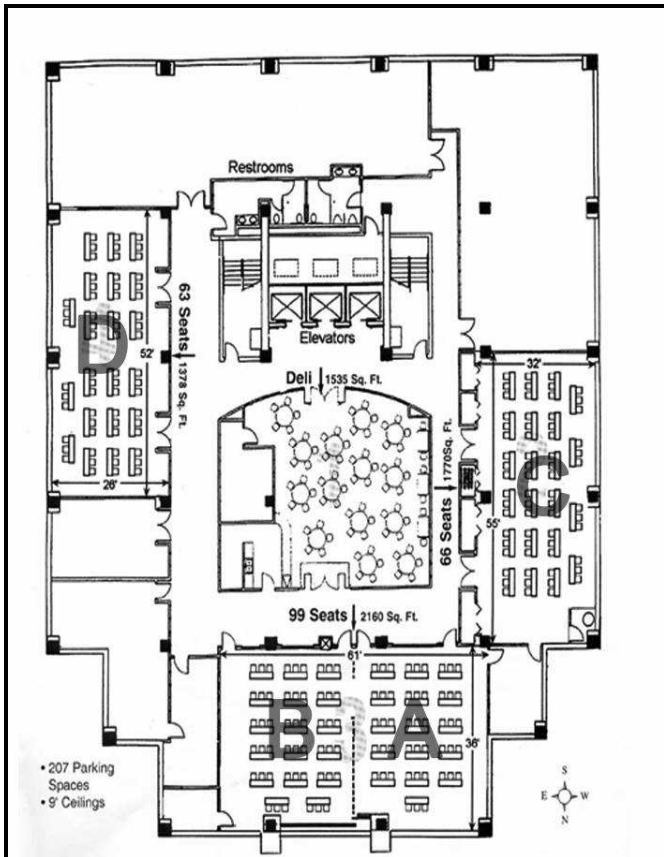
