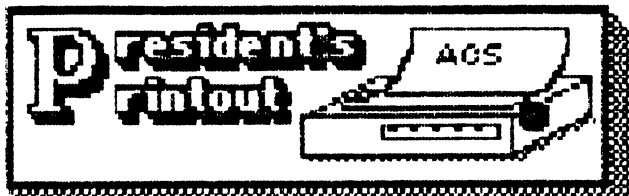

Eventually the conversation waned and, just as the sun set in the west, people started migrating to the lawn in front of the carving to see the laser and fireworks shows.

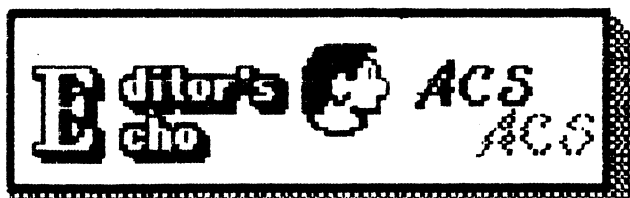
I heard reports that more than 10,000 people entered the park in time for

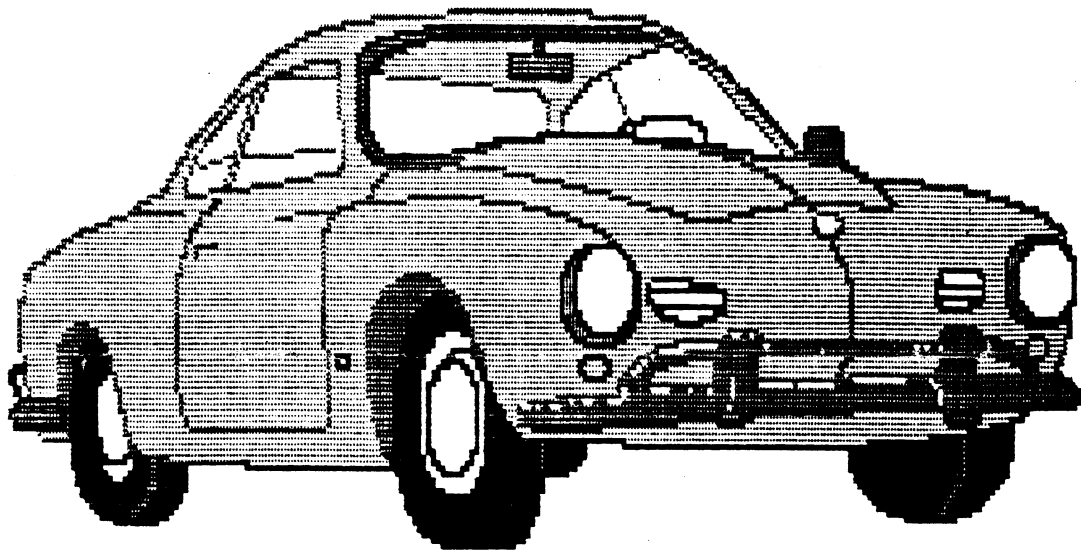

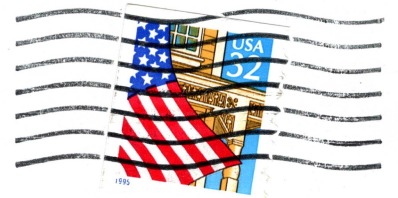
