Instructions For Use

This package includes two disks. Disk 1 is a "floppy." It is formatted on both sides under Disk BASIC and it must be turned over to access the programs on the back side. Disk 2 is a single-sided floppy. Before you run any of the programs from *The Fourth Rainbow Adventures Disk Set*, you should first use the Disk BASIC BACKUP command to make backups of Disk 1 (both sides) and Disk 2. Use these backups as working copies and store the originals in a safe place. For the protection of *The Fourth Rainbow Adventures Disk* originals, the disks do not have write-protect notches, so you cannot accidentally write to them.

The disks are menu-driven. To begin, type RUN"MENU" and press ENTER. A menu of the files appears, from which you may run some of the BASIC programs by pressing its corresponding letter key.

Some of the programs will not run properly from the menu due to memory limitations or special commands required before loading. When a file is run from *The Fourth Rainbow Adventure Disk* menu, some commands in the menu program remain in effect. Because of this, you may encounter an OM? Error on some of the programs, indicating that the file is too large for memory. If this occurs, remove the disk from the drive and turn off your Color Computer for about 15 seconds, then LOAD and RUN the program as you normally would from Disk BASIC, bypassing the menu. The files indicated by an asterisk require special instructions before loading. In many cases, certain files for that feature must be run in order to create data files used by the main program. Also, some of the feature programs require vast amounts of disk space for data storage. For *Life*, *Term Paper* and *The Earth's Foundation*, copy related files to a single disk and use that disk only while running the Adventure.
