If, while loading or running a program, you get a FC, OM, or SN error, you probably have to enter the PMODE and PCLEAR values for the program from the keyboard. The label on the tape also contains the PMODE and PCLEAR values. Locations for the programs are set for the Radio Shack CTR-80. Your locations may vary slightly. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If all three do not load, then send it back for prompt replacement.

Welcome to our March addition of Cococassette. This month we are celebrating Saint Patrick's Day. Notice the green sheets! We want to welcome the new subscribers. Notice that the tape must be rewound before being played. Note: If you do have problems loading a tape, make sure that the faulty part is not your recorder.

1. TIME MACHINE COVER - Travel thru time with the Coco Robot and get a brief history of the computer.
2. TRIG DEMO - This program uses trigonometric functions to display 3-D graphs for the Color Computer as graphic entertainment. Since the execution time of different formulas takes a long time, a sample picture is ready to load. Note: This program does not work 100% when your disk drive is inserted.

3. PYRAMID OF CHEOPS - This one or two player game involves an Anthropologist trying to get out of a pyramid. Try to beat your old time and do not get trapped by the Mummy's blockades.
4. PROGRAM PACKER - This machine language program will remove spaces and rem statement text from your basic programs. After loading in your basic program, 'CLOADM' this program and enter 'EXEC'. Disk users must type CLOADM "PACKER",2300. To save this program to cassette, non-disk users must enter CSAVEM "PACKER",1536,1740,1536. To save this program to disk, enter SAVEM "PACKER",3836,4040,3836.
5. BUDGET - This program will allow you to create a budget using your own categories. It allows you to save monthly expense data to tape or disk, print out information to a printer, and bar graph categories or yearly summaries.
6. ELECTRONIC DATEBOOK - Never miss another dentist appointment with this little electronic reminder. This home datebook-type program will allow you to enter, edit, save, load and display future dates, events, appointments, etc.
7. ML TUTORIAL PART 4 - This is the fourth installment in the series on machine language. This part deals with the branch instructions and condition codes register.
8. TAPE DIRECTORY - Place a directory in the front of your tapes for a quick reference.
9. BLOCK-STIR Armed with your trusty laser cannon, defend yourself from a moving wall of blocks. Use the right joystick to aim and fire.
10. COCO ADDING MACHINE - This program turns the Color Computer into a sophisticated adding machine. The program will accept input in the form of numbers and produce sub and grand totals. Each number may be accompanied by a description, but it is optional. The user may save his work to tape or disk and a printed report is available.

If you have problems loading the programs try changing the volume on your tape recorder. We have tested many tapes and all have come thru with flying colors.
