If, while loading or running a program, you get a FC, DM, or SN error, you probably have to enter the PMODE and PCLEAR values for the program from the keyboard. The label on the tape also contains the PMODE and PCLEAR values. Locations for the programs are set for the Radio Shack CTR-80. Your locations may vary slightly. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If all three do not load, then send it back for prompt replacement.

The program 'Autocopy' from Coco Cassette #28 will work great on your Coco with the following Pokes: POKE 4454,202:POKE 4455,04:POKE 4488,202:POKE 4489,04:POKE 4523,202:POKE 4524,04:POKE 4550,202:POKE 4551,04:POKE 4640,204:POKE 4641,36:POKE 4798,204:POKE 4799,36.

- DISK ROLL OUT - This utility provides a cheaper, more protected way to store disk backups using cassette. Save the entire disk contents, track by track, to cassette for possible future retrieval.
- ROBOT ON - Avoid the pursuing robots as you protect your humans. To control the movement of your player, use the right joystick. Move the left joystick in the direction you wish to fire. This program and the next program use the high speed poke. Make sure you reset the computer before doing input/output to tape or disk.
- MULTI PONG - Two players must battle it out in this pong version. This game allows you to move the paddles horizontally as well as vertically.

4. ADVENTURE GENERATOR AND INSTRUCTIONS - These two programs provide the instructions and the utility itself for generating your own adventures. After you create an adventure map, describe as many as three hundred rooms, put objects in these rooms, the adventure generator will provide you with the basics of your adventure game. This program will save you time from doing a lot of tedious typing that is required in writing adventure games. Because of its complexity, the adventure generator requires 32K.

5. QUEST INSTRUCTIONS AND QUEST ADVENTURE - This adventure game (written with the adventure generator), just fit in 16K with a Pclear 0. Therefore, a separate program with instructions is also presented. In this adventure game, you must retrieve the royal crown from the treasure room of the king's enemy.

6. QUARTER BOUNCE - Challenge your friends to a non alcoholic quarter bounce game on your computer. The right joystick is used as up to four players can compete.

Note: The next four programs are machine language programs. You must enter "CLOADM" instead of "CLOAD" and "EXEC" instead of "RUN".

7. DUAL - This utility will cause all output to the screen to go to the screen and the printer. This program is handy for things like - printing your directory, adding hard-copy output of in-program instructions, printing a run of a program for display or debugging purposes. To use: Get your printer ready. 16K - Enter Clear 200,16299. Cloads. Exec. 32K - Enter Clear 200,32683. Cloadm "DUAL",16384. Exec. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM "DUAL",16300,16383,16300.

8. KEY REPEAT - This utility will give you the power of automatic repeating keys. To use: 16K - Enter Clear 200,16199. Cloads. Exec. 32K - Enter Clear 200,32584. Cloadm "KEYREPET",16384. Exec. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM"KEYREPET",16200,16383,16200.

9. FULL EDITOR - With the full screen editor you can edit line numbers and correct immediate mode syntax errors without retyping the whole thing. To use: Follow the loading instructions. List some bad lines. Hit the right arrow key to get in the edit mode. Move up, down, left, and right with the four arrow keys. To change a character, type the replacement character over it. Hit enter when you are finished with that line number. To load: 16K - Enter Clear 200,16099. Cloads. Exec. 32K - Enter Clear 200,32483. Cloadm "FULLEDIT",16384. Exec. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM"FULLEDIT",16100,16383,16100.

10. METEOR - This machine language game is like the arcade game 'Asteroids'. The controls are R - rotate left, I - rotate right, I - thrust, O - fire. Due to a shortage of memory, there are no in-program instructions. Before loading this program, 16K users must enter Clear 12,9999. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM "METEOR",10000,16383,10000.
