DISK USERS: Insert disk and run DIR. CASSETTE TAPE USERS: Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter **LOAD** or **LOADM**. If while loading or running a program, you get a FC, CM, or SM error, you probably have to enter the **P.MODE** and **PCLEAR** values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

1. **DRUNK DRIVING** - With so many states getting tougher on drunk driving, this program will help you tell when you've had too much! Drunk shows graphs relating to body weight, alcohol tolerance, and driving impairment. Before running this program, you should enter PCLEAR 4.

2. **CAR MANAGER** - This home applications program will compute and store automobile expense data. Data can be saved to tape or disk. Hard copy and screen output of reports are available.

3. SQUEEZE - Squeeze is a hi-res game where you must shoot down the bouncing balls without the balls hitting you. Don't let the all-yellow ball reach the bottom, it might explode.

4. SUPER BACKUP - This particular disk backup utility gives a tremendous speed advantage over BASIC'S built-in backup command when copying a partially full disk. This program copies only the granules which are being used. Note: You may wish to power off the computer after using this program.

5. RECIPE MACHINE - This menu-driven home application program will help you organize your personal recipe file. The data can be saved and loaded with tape or disk. If you have a printer, then you can get a hard copy output.

6. ANTI-AIRCRAFT - Use the right joystick to control your anti-aircraft gun. While you are firing at the enemy, they are trying to hit you with bombs. The game is over when you are hit by ten bombs.

7. UNREASON ADVENTURE - Unreason is a 32K text adventure game. In the land of unreason, strange things happen and you must stay on your guard every moment.

8. TALKING ALPHABET - This program will help tutor young children with the alphabet. Pressing a letter key will cause the letter to be displayed and pronounced by the computer. Pressing the space bar will cause the computer to run through the entire alphabet. When Talking Alphabet is RUN for the first time, some machine language is automatically loaded. The machine language will be loaded from disk if a disk drive is detected. Otherwise, the machine language will be loaded from tape. To save the machine language part, enter (C)SAVEM "TALKALML",12000,16249,12000.

9. SUPER VADERS - This 32K exciting machine language game requires a CLOADM for tape or LOADM"VADERS" for disk to load. To run this program, enter EXEC. The title page has all the information on the options and maneuvering keys. To save this program to tape or disk, enter (C)SAVEM "VADERS",9728,32450,16896.

10. AUTOMATIC EDITOR - When this utility is active, a BASIC error (such as ?SN or ?FC) will cause the computer to automatically go into the EDIT mode. This will only happen when an error results while a program is running. The line edited is the line where the error occurred. To use: 16K users must simply (C)LOADM the program and enter EXEC when ready. 32K users must load the utility with (C)LOADM "AUTOEDIT",16384. To copy this program to tape or disk, enter (C)SAVEM "AUTOEDIT",16200,16303,16200.
