DISK USERS: Insert disk and run 'DIR'. CASSETTE TAPE USERS: Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter 'LOAD' or 'LOADM'. If while loading or running a program, you get a FC, OM, or SN error, you probably have to enter the PMODE and PCLEAR values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

- STAR TREK** - Your mission is to seek out and destroy all Klingons invading your galaxy. Six commands give you control over the long range scanner, shields, photon torpedoes, warp engines, status reports, and the galaxy map display.
- HAM RADIO LOG** - This home applications program can be used by ham radio operators to create and maintain a computerized list of world-wide radio contacts. Screen output and printer output are supported. If desired, a mailing label may be printed of any entry. Each entry includes call letters, name, address, contact date, time, receiving frequency, and transmitting frequency.
- COCO WAR** - Coco War is a "RISK" type war game using high resolution graphics. The game can be played with two or three players. There are three separate parts to this game: The instructions program - "WAR-INS", the hi-res screen draw routine - "DRAW", and the actual game program - "COCO-WAR".

4. DISK LABELER - This utility program will help you neatly print disk labels on your printer. It will also allow you to save disk directories of different disks so you can view/print later.

5. SHIP WAR - It is time for a ship to ship battle on the high sea. You control a 250MM cannon with the right joystick. While you are firing at the enemy ships, they are firing torpedoes at your ship.

6. ELECTRIC COST - This home management program will help you keep track of your electrical costs. It will also display or print neat yearly reports. A high resolution 3-D bar graph is available to show electric costs month-by-month over the current calendar year.

7. MULTI-KEY BUFFER - This machine language utility program will give your color computer a 256 character type-ahead buffer. This means that you can type keys even when the computer is doing something else, (like LIST) and those keys will be saved on an area of memory and recalled later when the computer is searching for more keyboard input. Note: This program and the next three programs are machine language programs. You must enter CLOADM instead of CLOAD and EXEC instead of RUN. To save this program to tape or disk, enter (C)SAVEM"MULTIKEY",15900,16329,15900.

8. NUKE AVENGER - You control a tank as you shoot down air planes, parachutist and missiles. Avoid the bombs being dropped on you or you lose a tank. Also, you must shoot down all parachutist which reach the ground and will try to grenade your tank. The left joystick is used to control the tank and functions as follows. Moving the joystick left and right moves the tank left and right. Moving the joystick up and down changes the firing angle of the turret on the top of the tank. To save this program to tape or disk, enter (C)SAVEM "NUKEAVGN",9000,16001,9072.

9. CURSOR KING - With this utility, you can change your cursor to one of over 60000 possibilities. The new cursor will blink between two different characters. When you EXEC this, the cursor codes will be given a starting value. You can change the cursor with a POKE 251, first code, POKE 252, second code, POKE 253, cursor blank delay. The locations may be poked with any value between 0 and 255. 32K users should enter (C)LOADM"CRSKING",16384 when loading. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM"CRSRKING",16100,16216,16100.

10. SAND ROVER - Use the right joystick to travel about the desert searching for valuable treasures in this 32K game. Move your Rover left or right to avoid incoming missiles or push the fire button to intercept them before they collide with you. Push up on the joystick for a temporary jet blast to jump over the desert cacti and boulders which might be in your way. The distance to the next treasure is shown on the radar map at the bottom of the screen. AT higher difficulty levels, the missiles are faster and the menacing sand dragon makes his appearance. An additional Rover is awarded with every 10,000 points. To save this program to tape or disk, enter (C)SAVEM "ROVER",24576,29999,24576.
