DISK USERS: Insert disk. Load and run 'MENU'. **CASSETTE TAPE USERS:** Rewind the tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter 'LOAD'. Locations for the programs are set for the Commodore 1530 Datasette Unit. Your locations may vary slightly. If your tape or disk does not load properly, return it for a prompt replacement.

1. HOME INVENTORY - This home management program will help you manage lists of your possessions and other items. Keep track of items in the garage, attic, freezer, etc. Data can be saved and loaded to or from tape or disk. Up to 300 entries may be kept in a 32K sytem and 100 entries in a 16K system.
2. NINE BALL - This program is a color graphic billiard game for two people. The joysticks are used to control and position your cue sticks. The player with the right joystick must sink the blue colored balls and the player with the left joystick must sink the red ones.
3. PRINTER REVIEW - Choosing a new printer for your Color Computer can be confusing. With printer prices dropping, now may be a good time to buy. This program will give you information about printers and display a comparative list of nearly fifty printers. All printers listed are under \$1000, yet some have features which not so long ago were only found on models \$1500 - \$2000.

4. EXPLORER ADVENTURE - You are on board a spaceship en-route to Saturn when the computer goes crazy and tries to kill you. The object of the game is to outwit the computer and deactivate him. Disk users must do the following: 1. Power off - then on.
2. Enter POKE 25,14:POKE 26,1:POKE 3584,0:NEW 3. LOAD "EXPLORER"
4. DEL 2-7 5. RUN Non-Disk users must enter PCLEAR! before loading the program.

5. SPANISH LESSONS - This program features five spanish lessons selected from a central menu. Each lesson is about four screens long.

6. CROSS FIRE - The object of this game is to collect all three circular counters (100 pts. each) to complete each wave. There are, however, 40 rockets trying to hit you while you do this.

Note: The next four programs are machine language programs. You must enter 'CLOADM' instead of 'CLOAD' and 'EXEC' instead of 'RUN'.

7. RAM SAVER - This machine language utility for 64K color computers will modify BASIC so that the high resolution graphic screen will start at a different location in Random Access Memory which is normally not used by the system. All PMODES are accessible. Note: PCLEAR should not be executed while this utility is working. RAM SAVER can save anywhere from 1536 to 12288 bytes depending on the Pmode requirements of the program. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM*RAMSAVER*,16000,16099,16000.

8. GRAY LADY - In this multi screen joystick game, you are the sub trying to torpedo the fast moving ships. You get four torpedos, then after they are all gone from the screen, your torpedo supply is refreshed. The second screen has mines, the third screen the boats drop depth charges, and the fourth screen has mines and depth charges. On depth charges, they may not pass below your sub. You have four function keys: Clear - Adjust color sets
Break - End game R - Reset computer Enter - Pause game. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM*GRAYLADY*,9730,14112,9730.

9. JOYSTICK INPUT - If you ever need to type text on your computer and it would be handy to not have to be at the computer's keyboard, then you can get some use out of this utility. This utility will let you use the right joystick as a text entry device. Move the stick up and down to change the character. Press the fire button to select. Note: The "<" character is a backspace and that the "/" is equivalent to pressing enter. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM*JOYINPUT*,16000,16199,16000.

10. COSMIC SWEEPER - As the Cosmic Sweeper it is your mission to make each sector safe for travel by preceding your fleet and clearing the path of meteors. Use the right joystick to ascend, descend, go left, or right. Press the fire button to destroy meteors with your lasers. Your location within each sector is shown on the upper left portion of the screen. Cosmic Sweeper's shield strength is shown at the upper center. You can with-stand four collisions before your shield is depleted. The current sector being cleared and the number of meteors destroyed is shown at the bottom of the screen. Additional shield strength is awarded every 10,000 points. To save this 32K program, enter (C)SAVEM"COSMIC",12864,19440,12864.
