DISK USERS: Insert disk and run 'DIR'. CASSETTE TAPE USERS: Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter 'CLOAD' or 'CLOADM'. If while loading or running a program, you get a PC, DM, or SN error, you probably have to enter the PMODE and PCLEAR values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

Welcome to our 53rd issue. In case you were wondering... We plan on supporting the COCO III. We purchased two of the long awaited machines at the Rainbowfest in New Jersey and programs are already on the way.

1. CORE KILL - Core Kill is a challenging low resolution game. Your white ship must shoot through the blue and red walls to penetrate the vulnerable core. Defending the wall are orange guards. You must avoid them. This game gets more difficult as you get better.
2. LUCKY MONEY - Lucky Money is a game for 2-5 players where each player tries to gain the most money in five rounds and a jackpot round. In every round each player gets three spins to try to win cash while trying to avoid ZEROS and other bad things.
3. COOKIES - Cookies is a Halloween type 32K adventure game. One of your friends, (a sack-holding, card-carrying chocolate chip cookie fanatic), relates how he braved the terrors of a haunted house. He claims he tried bribing his escape with an ever present bag of edibles, adding that only two factors saved him - quick feet and even quicker dropping of the enormous cookie sack! You are challenged to duplicate his feat of entering and exiting safely.

Your closest friend, a Dwarf, offers to tag along as an aid. Use the following commands: C Chomp, D Down, E East, F Fight, I Inventory, N North, R Run, S South, T Total accumulated points, U Up, W West, and X Drop or extract.

4. NICE LIST - This utility program will let you generate nice looking BASIC program listings. They are handy for newsletters, computer clubs, or anybody who exchanges programs on hardcopy.
5. SPANISH - This Spanish program can quiz you on up to 100 questions. The Spanish word is displayed and then you must correctly enter the English equivalent. Your score is then displayed.
6. PAINT - Paint, a high resolution graphics editor, is the second program in the Workmate Series that started on Issue #52. This program is composed of two files, PAINT/WRK and GMENU/WRK. You should copy these two files onto the disk you made last month that contains the Workmate Master Menu, the Text utility, and the Calendar programs. It is recommended that Paint be run from the Workmate Master Menu Only. To save GMENU/WRK, enter (C)SAVEM "GMENU/WRK", 3584,9728,3584.
7. CAVERN CRUISER - This game program adds a new twist to lunar lander. This time, your ship is trapped with in a labyrinth or solid rock caverns. Not too many good landing places in this one, either. Use the left and right arrows to control lateral movement. The space-bar supplies upward thrust. A machine language file accompanies this program. To save this file, enter (C)SAVEM "CAVASSE",13736,16147,13736.
8. SNAPSHOT - Snapshot is a utility program that helps you create fast graphics presentation. You can create a module of pictures and then use a built-in machine language routine to handle the display work. This utility was used to create the graphics modules for our past Graphic Tour and Haunted House Adventures.
9. MEGA RACE - Mega Race is a game where you must race around the Star Track avoiding killer aliens. The right joystick is used to control the game movement.
10. KICK GUY - In Kick Guy, you are a clown at the bottom of the screen. The sky is full of balloons. As they fall, you must try to catch them on your head. This game can accommodate one or two players. The keyboard functions are: 1 and 2 for selecting number of players, Left/Right arrow for movement, Clear key to pause the game, Enter to resume, Space-Bar to kick, Break to end the game, and R to reset the computer. To save Kick Guy, enter (C)SAVEM "KICK GUY",21998,26249,21998.
