DISK USERS: Insert disk and run 'DIR'. **CASSETTE TAPE USERS:** Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter 'CLOAD' or 'CLOADM' if while loading or running a program, you get a FC, DM, or DN error, you probably have to enter the PMODE and PCLEAR values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

Welcome to our 62nd issue of subscription software. This month we have a different introduction program. It will display our disclaimer along with a graphic demonstration which will keep running until the space bar is pressed. When the space bar is pressed the (DIR) program will automatically be loaded on the disk version. Tape users must keep the play button depressed to load the machine language code.

- PENSION MANAGER** - This program can help you if you own a small business. It can keep track of pension funds and project future growth. This program can also be used at home to keep track of your pension fund and its potential. Note: When entering any date, enter a 6 digit number. The first two digits indicate the month and the last 4 indicate the year.
- HERBS** - This program will give you some useful information and hints on growing herbs in the home. Several different varieties are covered along with several different ways to grow them.
- THE CATALOGER** - This disk utility is great for categorizing your disk directories. You can add individual disk directories to one file and then save them, print them, sort them, plus do much more. This program is menu driven for your convenience.

4. RAIDERS - Outwit the flying idol as you try to gain treasures and points. Use the space bar and arrow keys as you try to get the high score.

5. ALPHABETIZATION - This educational program instructs young children in alphabetizing simple every day words. Look at the four words at the left. Find out which word is first in the alphabet. Enter the number next to the word then enter the number of the next word found next in the alphabet and so on. The computer will score you and time you.

6. UFO ATTACK - The UFO's attack in columns as you try to ward them off. Use the right joystick to control the action in this game. This program can use the high speed poke.

7. ELECTRONICS 5 - This is the fifth part of our series on Electronics. This month we will cover a basic component of electrical and electronic circuits: The Resistor. This program requires 32K and a second module called E5MOD. When you run the tape version of this program, leave the play button depressed so it will automatically load the E5MOD. To save the module, enter (C)SAVEM "E5MOD",20000,32600,30000.

8. RAMBO ADVENTURE -In this 32K graphic adventure you strike out to save your fellow brothers in arms from their terrible captors. Pack up your M-16 and go for the gusto. Note: Tape users must keep the play button depressed in order to load the adventure modules. To save any of the modules, enter (C)SAVEM*(name)*,20000,29030,20000.

9. BLOCKS - This machine language program will let you create 3-D block structures. By pressing the 1 key several times you will see several blocks appear, stacked on top of each other. Press the P key several times and you'll see columns of blocks. Pressing the N, R, C, B, S, Clear key, Minus sign, and space bar will also do things to the screen. Since this program is written in machine language, tape users must type CLOADM instead of CLOAD. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM"BLOCKS",10000,13750,10000.

10. CAVE - In this machine language game you must pilot a space ship past various obstacles in a multi-screen cavern. The arrow keys (right, left and up) control the ship. Collision with any object causes the loss of one of your 3 ships. The P key will pause the action. The C key will toggle the colors between buff and green. Also the break key will end the game. There is a bonus value shown on the right. It counts down and if you exit the cave, (30 rooms to the right) you get the bonus. You will see your ship fly up through the hole in the roof of the final room. To save the program, enter (C)SAVEM "CAVE",10000,14000,10000.

For you football fans: We've updated last years NFL86 program and included NFL87 this month. Using the 1986 Pro-season stats that are already stored in the main program, you can get predictions of all 16 games of each of the 26 teams. You can also alter these stats of some or all the teams by loading and editing a file called NFL. You can save this file to tape or disk to reload for later use. Scores of any week of play can be displayed or printed at any time.
