DISK USERS: Insert disk and run 'DIR'. CASSETTE TAPES USERS: Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter 'LOAD' or 'LOADM'. If while loading or running a program, you get a FC, OM, or SM error, you probably have to enter the P.MODE and PCLEAR values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

Welcome to our 80th issue of subscription software. In the last two months we have obtained over 1000 public domain programs for the color computer. Some were excellent, some were average, some were even junk or duplicates. We have gone through these 1000 programs and saved the best programs and added some of the newest ones from various bulletin boards. We hope to send you a catalog of 500 of the top public domain programs next month.

1. SCRABBLE - This two player game plays similar to the popular board game. Each player receives 7 lettered tiles. You must create a word with your tiles using other letters on the board. Use the arrow keys to maneuver the cursor to the beginning of the word. Press space bar when ready. Next, press the correct letters in the appropriate squares. Press <ENTER> when finished. Point values: Solid blue = double word score. Dotted blue = double letter score. Solid red = Triple word score. Dotted red = triple letter score.
2. SPELLING CHECKER - This spelling checker is a lot faster than the others we've published. This program requires 32k. The basic program will load two machine language programs - BDICT and SC. BDICT contains the vocabulary file and can be added too. To save BDICT, enter (C)SAVEM"BDICT",12000,25659,12000. To save SC, enter (C)SAVEM"SC",11000,11083,11000.

3. SANDSTONE ADVENTURE - In this 32K adventure you must find your kidnapped friend, Gary Lamburd. Your only clue is a Sandstone which was also stolen.

4. FAMILY FEUD - There are four programs provided for 'THE FEUD'. The first program, FEUD, contains the game itself. The second program, FEUD.BIN contains a low res graphic screen. The 3rd program, FEUD.DAT contains 40 questions and 160 answers. The last program, QUEST.BAS, allows you to add more questions/answers for the FEUD. To save FEUD.BIN, enter (C)SAVEM "FEUD",1024,1536,1024. Note: When playing the game for the second or third time and a question comes up that you have already had, enter an X for the answer and a new question will appear.

5. HARNESS HANDICAPPER - This program will help you handicap the harness horse races. It will help you to see how the horses compare to each other by entering the information provided with the racing program. This program will only work on the Coco 3.

6. MINIGOLF 3 - This is a fun graphics golfing game for the Coco 3. Play nine exciting holes of minigolf on your computer. Use the right joystick to aim the golf ball and hold the joystick button in in order to change the speed.

7. ULTIMATEM 3 - As we have mentioned earlier, we have viewed many public domain programs. Included in these programs were 8 terminal programs. This one, Ultimaterm, was by far the best. We have obtained permission from the author to publish this program. There is a basic program which precedes the main program called ULTSMAN. It can print a mini manual on your printer. Here are some of Ultimaterm's features: Has many pop-up help menus. Supports X-MODEM, Y-MODEM and X-MODEM Checksum. Supports 300 to 9600 baud. Supports a software clock on screen and a real-time clock as well. Supports multiple disk save features for text files larger the 153K. Supports 10 programmable macros. Supports 512K. Supports TTY ANSI-BBS as long as VIDTEX control codes. Supports autodial and redial. Supports DEC VT-52 and DEC VT-100 emulation with keypad support. Has 80 column screen plus you can save custom parameters to disk. And much, much more! Ultimaterm 3 will only work on a Coco 3 and requires a disk drive. Tape users: We could not put Ultimaterm 3 on tape. If you ever upgrade to a disk system, you can exchange your tape for a disk at no charge. To load Ultimaterm 3, disk users must simply enter LOADM"ULTITERM".

8. NETWORK TUTORIAL - This program explains the various types of computer networks. The four networks that we will discuss are BBS networks, the basic network, super networks, and local area networks.

9. A-MAZING PLACE - To run this ML program, you must first load and run MAZEBOOT which will automatically run MAZE. The object is to design your own maze using the arrow keys and then collect the dots in the maze. The program first places a few dots randomly in the maze area. Then you begin construction of the walls. A dot is placed in the beginning and end points of each wall segment. You continue drawing a wall segment until you work yourself into a corner. This continues until the maze is complete. Then your man appears and the game proceeds. Try to recover all the dots as quickly as possible. Although the game can be played solo, it's most fun when two people play and try to make the hardest maze for each other. The C key flips the screen colors. To save the ML part, enter (C)SAVEM"MAZE",10000,13254,10000.

10. MONEYOPOLY - Here is another one of TOM MIX favorites that we have paid for the rights to publish. The object of the game is to buy and rent or sell properties so profitably that one becomes the wealthiest player and eventually wins the game. You may purchase property, build houses and hotels and collect rent from other players who stop there. The game is played with 2,3 or 4 players. It is a fast-paced game because the computer does all the work. Follow the directions in this 32K machine language program. To load, enter CLOADM from tape or LOADM"MONEY" for disk.
