**DISK USERS:** Insert disk and run DIR. **CASSETTE TAPE USERS:** Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Press Forward to display program's tape counter number and enter 'LOAD' or 'CLOAD'. If while loading or rewinding a program, you get a FC, DM, or SN error, you probably have to enter the PMODE and PCLEAR values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

- PENTA-SAME** - This program provides a unique version of Yahtzee. Along with trying to make a match of the same numbers, you must try to match the same shapes. You get three rolls with the dice each time and then you select which category you want your score put in. Use any key to toggle your selection and use the <enter> key to select. Along with some of the same categories you find in Yahtzee, there are some additional ones. For instance: Full House also requires you to have the same symbols.
- ROTISSERIE LEAGUE** - Rotisserie league involves up to ten players getting together acting as owners of their own baseball teams. You each acquire 23 players through drafting and, later on, trading. Each team is made up from all the teams in the American League or National League. You pay your players (money goes into a pot) salaries just like a real team owner. Stats are accumulated on each of your players, and points are awarded depending on how

your players do. At the end of the season, the player with the most points wins the biggest chunk of the money from the pot. We have included an instructional program called ROTISINS with more information. The main program ROTIS is designed to help the league secretary keep track of the league stats.

3. NICK'S QUEST - This adventure is about a guy named Nick who is hunting for the 'Ward of Wonder' to save his kingdom. The game starts with him in front of the entrance to the 'Cave of Lost Souls'. This program accepts three letter abbreviations of words. If you type 'Words' into the command mode, a list of words the program will accept will appear.
4. SOLITAIR - Try to reverse the blue and yellow circles in as few as moves as possible. A circle may be moved from one square to any vacant square along side of it or it may jump over an adjoining occupied square to a vacant one. Use the <ENTER> key to select and then press 1 or 2 to jump along with the appropriate arrow key.
5. EDUCATION 4 - This educational program consists of 4 sections. They are as follows: 1. Negative - Teaches the standard usage of negatives in grammar. 2. There - Demonstrates how the words there, they're and there are used. 3. May/can - Assists you in determining the correct use of the words may and can. 4. Bonus - Generates a screen/hard copy of a multiplication table.
6. IBM - BASIC DIFFERENCE - This program provides you with information on the differences between IBM PC Basic and the Cocom's Basic. You can get a hard copy of the information at any time by pressing 'P'.
7. BASEBALL CARD ORGANIZER - This program allows you to keep track of your baseball cards on tape or disk. You can have up to 12 different classifications along with up to 12 different manufacturers. Card data includes name, year value, manufacturer, classification, and team. You can also print a report out to your printer.
8. MUNCHY 3 - This Pacman type game is played similar to the arcade game. This program requires a Cocom 3. There is a basic program called MUNCHY which automatically loads up the ML file called MUNCHGPB. RGB users can change the 'CMP' command to 'RGB' in lines 6, 219, and 285. To save the ML file, enter (C)SAVEM "MUNCHGPB",16384,24575,16537.
9. RIVER RAID 3 - This Cocom 3 only program involves running you Raidboat up the perilous river. Use your right joystick to maneuver the boat and the button to fire at the obstacles. A map will show you each of the five stages. This program requires disk and is 19 granules long. There is an instructional program called RIVERINS. The ML program 'RIVER' uses a data file called 'RIVROOMS'. To save RIVER, enter SAVEM "RIVER",4096,32479,4096.
10. CUBER - You are an orange creature that must travel around a pyramid of 28 cubes and change the tops of all of them. The color of the cube is changed by hopping on it once in level 1 and twice in level 2. On levels 3 and 4 each jump will change the color back and forth. On every level, jumping off the pyramid causes Cuber to fall unless he happens to land on a disc. Each disc can be used only once. There are four rounds per level. If you have a RGB monitor, we've enclosed our RGB patch on this issue. Simply CLOADM or LOADM"RGBAFIX" and then enter EXEC. Then LOADM"CUBER" and enter EXEC to play in color. To save this program, enter (C)SAVEM "CUBER",10240,20735,10240.
