DISK USERS: Insert disk and run **DIR**. **CASSETTE TAPE USERS:** Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter **CLOAD** or **CLDADM**. If while loading or running a program, you get a **FC**, **OM**, or **SN** error, you probably have to enter the **FMODE** and **PCLEAR** values from the keyboard. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

- 1. PERSONNEL FILE** - This program is great if you own a small business and need help keeping tabs on all the people in the office. You can also use this program to jot down notes on important clients. This program is totally menu driven for convenience. To add a date simply type it in. In addition, it allows you to sort, edit, and even print out the information.
- 2. QUEST FOR CHAOS** - You have been called from the realm of dreams to restore it to the way that it once was. This text adventure game uses two letter commands like "open book" to perform an action. To move, simply type the first letter of the direction you want to go. If you need further instructions there is an instructional program which precedes the main program called **CHAOSINS**.
- 3. RETIREMENT ACCOUNT** - By asking for your balance, interest rate, monthly deposit, and amount of withdrawals per month, this program help you plan your retirement account. With a small investment of time, you can know how much money you are hoping to have when you retire. This program will also provide you with nice printouts for a hard copy of the information created.

4. **ALPHABET SCRAMBLER 3** - This Coco 3 only challenging puzzle game is highly addictive. You start out choosing the number of times that want your letters to be shuffled around on the board (between 1 and 10,000). It is then your job to organize them back into their original order. Use the arrow keys to put the appropriate letter in the blank spot. How quickly can you solve the scrambled puzzle?
5. **POKER** - Planning a trip to Vegas? Then this Coco 3 only program is for you. Before you risk your hard earned cash with the poker machines, take in a little practice. Use the arrow keys to choose the cards you don't want, and the "T" key to throw them away. If you think you can stand on what you have, push "enter". Good luck!
6. **FINANCE BUNDLE** - This program will help you keep those bill collectors away that keep banging on the door. It allows you to keep track of both your savings and your loans. You can use each program to help calculate useful information like for instance, how much money you can borrow for a loan, or how much interest will be compounded in a savings account. Each of the nine options are very simple to use. When it asks for information, answer the questions to your best knowledge and it will give a very precise calculation. It is great for those looking to finance a car!
7. **SILENCE SYNDROME** - The Western Front isn't the only thing that's quiet in this text adventure game. You find yourself in an outdoor cafe, but the world seems to be totally without sound. It is your mission to solve this mystery and bring back the sound. As with most text adventures, it is run by typing two word commands, such as "get pencil" or "buy pencil". You can also type N, S, E, W for moving North, South, East or West.
8. **MR. BILL** - If you are trying to keep track of all your outstanding invoices, then this program is great for you. Your first step in running this program is to add all the companies that you are on terms with. You can then enter in all the transactions as they appear day to day. This program works with tape or disk and printouts are available.
9. **COAST-TO-COAST** - In this game, you are a truck driver struggling to make ends meet. You are given a choice of three trucks, varying in cost and age. You are then given a selection of loads to carry across country. As in real life, you face problems any trucker would: Speeding tickets, truck payments, food costs, insurance, and days where you just can't find a load. Good luck, and remember, **KEEP ON TRUCKING!**
10. **GOPHER 3** - I've heard this Coco 3 only game described as a cross between Pac-Man and Dig-Dug, and that has to be the best description that I can come up with. You are a hungry gopher trying to eat red proteins and roots while staying away from the deadly snake. As a gopher, you can dig through the earth, but watch out. There is a limit to the number of times this can be done.
