DISK USERS: Insert disk and run DIR. **CASSETTE TAPE USERS:** Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter CLOAD or CLOADM.
If while loading or running a program, you get a FC, OM, or SN error, you probably have to enter the PLOAD and PLOADM values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

Welcome to our 112th issue of CoCo Software. The snow is starting to pile up outside, but we've put together ten "hot CoCo" programs to warm up your winter months. So pop the disk into the drive and let's go!

1. **BOWLER'S HELPER** - In a bowling league? Tired of using fifteen pounds of paper to keep track of all the stats? Then relax - we've got the program for you. Bowler's Helper will support up to 40 teams, with up to 6 bowlers per team. The information can be even be sorted and printed.

2. **POOL PLAYER** - This program is a joy-stick driven pool game for one or two players. Just line up the cross hairs and push the button. With four skill levels this game promises to bring hours of enjoyment to your family. It's like going to a pool hall with out having to deal with all the smoke.

3. **MUSIC MAN** - You and this program can make beautiful music together! It even lets you save your music and modify its tempo and octave. Some knowledge of music terminology is useful for the full use of this program. Who needs an expensive synthesizer? The program comes with a sample already to be compiled, after you compile it, simply press 4 to play music

4. **GUEST LIST** - This one is for all of you party animals out there. It will help organize your guest lists for parties, receptions, and other functions. The data can be saved to disk or tape, and used to print total reports, place markers for table settings, or even mailing mailing labels. Enjoy and remember to save a piece of cake for me.

5. **SERPENT** - In this game you are a growing snake who needs to eat his fruit to provide nourishment. But remember, don't eat the unripe fruit, it will give you a upset stomach! As an added feature, the program allows you to program you own control keys. Run serpent2 if you have a CoCo 2 or serpent3 if you have a CoCo 3.

6. **FORWARD DICE** - Develop nerves of steel! You and your opponent take turns rolling a set of dice. Who ever scores a total of 128 first, wins. Simple, right? But wait! There's a catch. If you roll doubles, you are allowed to keep on rolling until you decide to stop, or if you get another set of doubles. In which case your points are returned to zero, and you have to start all over again. GOOD LUCK!

7. **CoCo TOOLS** - Sore, aching fingers? Then take an aspirin and enjoy CoCo Tools. This program will cut down on the amount of keystrokes you need to do everyday tasks such as asking for a directory, copying or formatting a disk, killing or renaming a file, or even copying a single file.

8. **PAKFIX** - This program is for those of you who may be having problems getting your CoCo 3 to work with your modem.

9. **GNOME QUEST** - In this CoCo 3 only graphics game, nobody "gnomes" the trouble you'll see! You are the prince of the gnomes, and as such, it is your duty to rescue the three treasures of the gnomes that were stolen by an evil wizard. But beware, a journey though a treacherous mountain filled with spirits is required. While in the mountain, use the joy-stick to manipulate your gnome from stone to stone, pushing the button to jump. But remember you only have three lives! For more information run the "manual" program.

10. **BIRDS** - Remember the Alfred Hitchcock movie? Well, guess what. They're back! In this Tom Mix graphics game shoot down the birds before they do you (or is that do-do you?). Joy-stick controlled, this is a fast pace enjoyable game with good graphics that I'm sure you will like. To run this program enter LOADM"BIRDS" for disk or CLOADM"BIRDS" for tape, enter EXEC to run. To save to tape or disk 10752, 15629, 10752.
