**DISK USERS:** Insert disk and run DIR. **CASSETTE TAPE USERS:** Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter 'CLOAD' or 'CLOADM'.

If while loading or running a program, you get a PC, DM, or CC error, you probably have to enter the PMODE and PCLEAR values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it has one, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

Welcome to the 119th issue of Color Computer Software. With the weather so nice here in Michigan, it is kind of hard to get the Coco issues out on time. We hope you especially enjoy this month's exciting selection of software.

**1. LARGE, MEDIUM, SMALL TITLES-** These three utilities will do the work of making a title screen that will introduce your program while the main program is loading. The program has an inverse option which will specify the background color. When you are done with the title screen press the clear key to save the title to disk.

**2. PICTURE MAKER-** This program is for those of you who go out and spend money for programs that make banners, greeting cards, etc. but cannot find any programs to make their own pictures. Some samples are already included with the program or you can make your own pictures. As soon as you are in the Work Area press the "C" key to set the color of your brush or press "E" to erase. Use the space bar to undo the color and eraser functions. The L key saves the picture and CLEAR key will let you create a new picture.

3. **SQUARE**- The object of this game is to place a number of different colored tiles with your keyboard into a grid so that no two colors wind up in the same row or line; vertically, horizontally, or diagonally. The game has to be calibrated for your make of monitor (RGB or CMP).

4. **DISK CHECKER**- This program will check for bad sectors, granules and lock them out so they will never be used again. Watch out when using this program with 40 or 80 track disks. The author says that there is no reason this program will not work on those disks but the software is designed for use only on 35 track disks.

5. **HINTS**- This is a simple program that uses the speech cartridge. Make sure that your cartridge is installed before you run this program and sit back and have a good conversation with your computer.

6. **LOTTO PREDICTIONS**- Don't you just hate going to the store and picking lottery numbers the same as your birthday or wedding anniversary and they never win? This program gives you the random numbers for the largest profits, (44 different numbers to chose from).

7. **POCKETBALL**- This fast joystick game is a great toy to keep you busy on your CoCo. Try to bounce the ball into the colored pockets. Each one is worth a different amount of points. The white ring gives you a free ball.

8. **RAMTEST**- Test the reliability of all ram in your CoCo. It does this by writing data to your ram and then reading it back and see the dependability and compare the read back from the input.

9. **COCO DIR. MANAGER**- This shareware version is the most convenient for handling directories for the CoCo. It does everything from locking files for protection to alphabetize your directory and lets you read text files and run your programs all from one environment. I recommend tuning into this program as soon as you load 119.

10. **MUTANT ATTACK**- Your object is to avoid the masses of space aliens coming to attack you in this machine language program. Use your arrow keys to move and the down arrow will clear out all the fleets of aliens, to "SAVEM" type 19000, 32736, 30884. Good luck!
