**DISK USERS:** Insert disk and run 'DIR'. **CASSETTE TAPE USERS:** Rewind tape. Zero the tape counter. Fast Forward to desired program's tape counter number and enter 'LOAD' or 'LOADMR'. If while loading or running a program, you get a FC, OM, or SM error, you probably have to enter the PMODE and PCLEAR values from the keyboard. We try to put as many duplicates of the programs on tape as possible. If the first copy does not load, try the second copy, or if it fails even, the third. If you cannot get the tape or disk to load the programs properly, then send it back for a prompt replacement.

1. **XMAS** - Here is a great program for this time of the year. Each Christmas song comes complete with a picture. Here are some of the great examples of the Christmas favorites on this disk: Jingle bells, Silent Night, Hark the Harold Angles Sing, and more!
2. **GLADIATOR DUEL** - In this text game you take on the part of a gladiator and fight four opponents. To win, you must fight and defeat your opponent. You pick the type of defense and offense that you want, try to pick the correct block. You can also choose an evade to build up fatigue points. You need fatigue in order to

attack.

3. KUTULU - This is a text adventure game where you type in the letter of the direction that you want to go. Example "N" for North, Etc...
4. SEARUNNER - You must pilot the Navy's latest development, The Sea-runner, against armed hostile Syrian craft in the Red Sea. Try to sink their ship before they hit you and end the game.
5. T&D INDEX - This program contains all the data from issues 1-118. For each program the following is included: Issue #, program name, language type, program subject, memory required, CoCo 3 or not, Disk, Printer, and joystick. This is by far the best of this type of program that we have ever seen. Two copies of ramdisks are included. If you are going to use this program for a long time then we suggest that you load a ram disk and copy the program.dat file to the ram disk.

#### Disk 2 -

We've enclosed a second disk with this issue. It includes four large pictures digitized with an IBM Video Blaster and then converted for the Cocom. To view any of the graphics simply run the program "VIEW". Position the right joystick to load a MAC file. Select the correct file and press the Joystick button to load. After the picture is loaded, select the view option.

Picture 1 OFFICE- The office pictured here was in 1984 in the front bedroom of a mobile home. You can see the old style CoCo and disk drives as well as the 23 year old entrepreneur hard at work. Instead of a monitor we were still using a color TV.

Picture 2 TAPE DECK- Here we have a picture of a chain of 10 tape decks used to make cassette tape duplicates. At one time we had over 700 tape subscribers, each tape took 30 minutes to duplicate, we could duplicate close to 20 an hour. The tape players required constant upkeep as well as replacements each month.

Picture 3 RAINBOWFEST- Here we have a picture of one of our display booths at the Chicago Rainbowfest. We would often rent two booths so we could display all of our titles. We spent a lot of money getting professional signs done up. This was the chance we had to meet with the public and get new ideas.

Picture 4 COMPUTERS & MORE- Computers And More has grown from a one man operation to six men. We have over 2800 square feet in a growing town. We sell hardware and software for the IBM compatibles primarily but display software for the C64, Amiga, Apple, and the CoCo as well.
