### PROGRAMMING THE TRS-80

On this month's issue of 'TRS-80 COMPUTING' we decided to start you off in programming. This has to do with the following commands: INPUT, PRINT, GOTO and IF/THEN.

PRINT-Tells the computer to print anything in quotes.

GOTO-Tells the computer to goto a specific line number.

INPUT-The computer waits input is received. It calls it a letter. If it is a character it could be A\$. If it is a number it could be A.

To see how these commands work, type in the following program:

- 10 CLS
- 20 PRINT"TO MAKE ME CHANGE COLORS, TYPE A NUMBER FROM 0-8."
- 30 INPUT T
- 40 CLS(T)
- 50 PRINT"WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE THE COLORS AGAIN ?"
- 60 INPUT R\$
- 70 IF R\$="Y"THEN GOTO 10
- BØ IF R\$="N"THEN END

NOTE: When using INPUT commands, the letter doesn't nesseceraly have to be 'R $^{\circ}$ ' or 'T'. It can be any letter in the alphabet.



REMARKS: The new Color Computer 3 improves on the Color Computer 2 in a number o One of them is that the CoCo 3 can use a rgb moniter which allows you t print 64 high-resoulution colors. At the same time you can use a TV for displ y which makes a fine system for young kids. The standard 128K memory along wit a 80 X 24 text display suggests the ability to run sophisticated software. The OS-9 operating system lets you run two or more programs at once.

High level software has been slow in coming, but while you wait you can u e the software and hardware that works with the older CoCo 2. However you may f nd more software for the Apple II and C 128 still stick with the Radio Shack so

### MACHINE SPECIFICS

The first of the Tandy distributed CoCo 3 software, running under OS-9 Level II, has finally started to arrive. Epyx's Rogue(Cat No.26-3297;\$29.95)has been put in the CoCo 3 format, as has the Epyx/Lucasfilm Koronis Rift(Cat No.26-3298;\$29.95). Both have been available for other computers.

The color, sound, and animation on Rift are nothing short of wonderful-at le ast on the Tandy CM-8 RGB moniter. However, the game really doesn't move fast e nough to be classified as a arcade shoot-'em up, and there are not enough puzzle s to be classed as a first rate adventure. The sound, color, and cute robots are enough to keep young children interested.

Rogue, on the other hand, is short on color, graphics, sound, and animation, but it is really more of a challenge.

A SHORT COCO LEASH.A couple of CoCo 3 owners were complaining about the short cable furnished with the CM-8 RGBI moniter. The short leash makes it impossible to place the moniter any distance from the computer. That problem can be solved by ordering a six-foot moniter extension cable from Spectrum Projects(\$19.95;P.O.Box 264, Howard Beach, New York).
