LOADING: To load the cassette version, insert the cassette into the recorder, press the PLAY button, type CLOADM and hit ENTER. The tape will load and auto-execute. If you have the disk version, insert the diskette into the drive, close the door, and type RUN"BARTEND". Then hit ENTER.

WARRANTY: The media upon which the program is recorded is guaranteed to load for one year. There is no other warranty, either expressed or implied.

The Eight Bit Bartender was designed for use by the novice as well as the expert mixologist. Both will find a wide variety of drinks served in the finest cocktail lounges. However, the "Bartender" was intended as a guide rather than the end-all and be-all of recipes. In that spirit, (pun intended) we encourage you to experiment with the ingredients of our drinks if they don't meet with your individual taste. Remember, the part you play in the mixing of these drinks is the most important ingredient of all!

A short review of the terms and their definitions as used in this guide may be helpful. Always follow the instructions accurately. When it says STIR, that is the thing to do. The length of time a drink is stirred is important, for the ice is melting all the time. Too much stirring dilutes the drink, too little fails to chill and mix the ingredients properly. When it says SHAKE, then shake. and use cracked or cubed ice unless otherwise noted. Use of an electric blender is intended with the instruction BLEND. Sometimes, when preparing frozen drinks, it may be necessary to turn the blender on and off several times to get a thick, smooth mixture. When preparing hot drinks that are served in a glass, we recommend a spoon be placed in the glass BEFORE pouring the hot mixture in. This will prevent the glass from cracking.

The use of mixers (especially carbonated ones) can be critical to the success of your drink. Always use fresh carbonated mixers that won't go flat in the glass. Carbonated water, charged water, seltzer and club soda are essentially the same thing. They are listed as SODA in these recipes. Also, quinine water is listed as TONIC. When the recipe calls for a BOTTLE of an ALCOHOLIC beverage, we mean 4/5 QUART size. SUGAR is GRANULATED, unless otherwise noted.

Use the correct glassware as noted in the recipes. They help to make the drink just as "clothes help to make the man". The following is a list of standard sizes of glasses:

Whiskey	1 oz. to 2 1/2 oz.	Old Fashioned	4 oz. to 6 oz.
Cocktail	2 oz. to 3 1/2 oz.	Highball	8 oz. to 10 oz.
Champagne	5 oz. to 6 oz.	Tom Collins	10 oz. to 14 oz.
Cordial	3/4 oz. to 1 oz.		

With The Eight Bit Bartender, drinks can be searched in three fields and all drinks are cross referenced. If you want the recipe for a particular drink, type in the name and it will show on the screen. If the recipe is not included in this guide, an "I don't serve that!" message will appear. Drinks can also be searched for by category, i.e. Cocktail, Highball, Punch, Tall & Cool, Chill Chaser (hot drink). You will notice that the categories are also color coded: Buff, Yellow, Orange, Blue and Red respectively. For purposes of identification, we have categorized drinks in this manner: Cocktails are served in Cocktail or Old Fashioned glasses, Highballs are those drinks usually served in Highball glasses, Tall and Cool drinks are those served in Collins glasses. Finally, you may search the drinks by "main liquor". For example, if you are looking for a drink made with vodka, type in vodka and the Bartender will show you all the drinks he serves containing vodka as the main liquor. The same is true of drinks made with scotch, rye, tequila, wine, rum, bourbon, brandy, and sloe gin. Liqueurs may also be asked for by name. WHISKEY refers to any BLENDED WHISKEY, such as Seagram's Seven, Canadian, etc..

A great deal of research went into compiling this guide. The most common recipes from across America have been incorporated, thanks to the cooperation of popular cocktail lounges in major cities. We are delighted with the result. We hope you have similar feelings. Enclosed is an alphabetical listing of the recipes contained in The Eight Bit Bartender.
