

LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

Insert Disk Tutorial Disk #1 in Disk Drive 0 and type: RUN "BOOT". When the title screen appears, press any key to go to Part I of the Tutorial.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This Disk Tutorial is composed of 10 parts, with 5 parts on each of the two disks. Each part deals with a specific aspect of the Disk Operating System.

The information in each part is displayed on the text screen. After you have read the text displayed on the screen, press any key to move to the next screen.

Each part of the tutorial also contains utilities which help in better understanding and use of information. For your convenience, these utilities have been typed in for you and are included in two programs -DISK UTILITIES I and DISK UTILITIES II. At the end of each part you may press 'R' to run DISK UTILITIES I / DISK UTILITIES II or (SPACEBAR) to move on to the next part. After Part 5, computer will prompt you to switch disks. At this point remove Disk insert Disk #2 and press the <SPACEBAR>
