COLORWARE

MAX FONTS is a collection of new and different text fonts for use with the CoCo MAX graphics package. These new fonts can be typed onto the screen utilizing all of CoCo MAX's text style combinations such as bold, italics, outline, and so forth. The font names will automatically appear in CoCo MAX's pull down menu.

MAX FONTS requires the CoCo MAX program for operation. Both CoCo MAX II and the original version of CoCo MAX are supported.

GETTING STARTED

The diskette you received contains twenty-four different fonts; each font is contained in a separate file, with the extension .FNT. In order for CoCo MAX to know how to access these fonts, it has to know both their file names, and the descriptive text that appears in the pull-down FONTS menu. This information is stored in the following configuration files:

ORIGINAL.BIN
MAXFONTA.BIN
MAXFONTB.BIN
MAXFONTB.BIN
MAXFONTC.BIN
MAXFONTD.BIN
MAXFONTE.BIN
MAXFONTE.BIN

The .MAF files are for use with CoCo MAX II, while the .BIN files are for use with the original version of CoCo MAX. The two MAXFONT-.MAF files each contain the names of 12 fonts, while the six MAXFONT-.BIN files each contain the names of 4 fonts. The files ORIGINAL.MAF and ORIGINAL.BIN contain the original CoCo MAX I and II font names, and are provided so you can access the original CoCo MAX fonts after using MAX FONTS.

USING THE FONTS

To use these fonts while in CoCo MAX, boot up CoCo MAX as you normally do. Then, when you want to use the new fonts, remove your CoCo MAX system diskette from drive 0 and insert your MAX FONTS diskette. Then perform the following procedure which applies to you:

CoCo MAX II:

Click on the FILE menu, and verify that the Drive # shown is zero (0). Then select the LOAD PAGE function. The file names MAXFONTA and MAXFONTB should appear in the upper part of the window. Click on one of these names; this will cause the configuration information in that .MAF file to be loaded into CoCo MAX. Your current picture will not be affected.

CoCo MAX I:

Click on the FILE menu, and select the QUIT function. When the "OK" prompt appears, type the following BASIC command:

LOADM "MAXFONTA": RUN

Substitute the appropriate name above, depending on which group of 4 fonts you wish to select. The effect is the same as the previous example.

After you have done the above step, click on the FONTS menu; you will see the new font descriptions in place of the original CoCo MAX names. Select and use the new fonts in the same ways as the original ones.

Since your CoCo MAX system diskette is not in the drive when you are using MAX FONTS, you should take care while performing Cut, Copy, Paste, or Clip Book operations, since these functions access special files on the system disk.

If, after using MAX FONTS, you wish to return to the original CoCo MAX fonts, perform the above configuration file loading procedure, except with the file ORIGINAL. Then, replace the CoCo MAX system diskette in drive 0, and access the files as before.

As with the original CoCo MAX fonts, not all of the possible characters will be available in all of the fonts. Refer to the information pertaining to the font set which you ordered, as well as application hints for certain specialty fonts.

The words "Full", "Letters", and "Symbols" indicate the number and range of characters that are available in a particular font style and/or size. "Full" means that all characters (upper and lower case letters, numbers, and punctuation) are available; "Letters" means that only the upper and lower case letters are available; "Symbols" means that only the upper case letters, numbers, and punctuation are available.

The "Books" and "Tableau" fonts produce character shapes with no white space between them. The "<" and ">" characters are used to begin and end the patterns. For the "Books" font, the "(" and ")" characters create the book ends, as shown in the print samples.

SPECIAL NOTES

The "Moscow" fonts are small and large renditions of the Russian, or Cyrillic, alphabet. The letter placement on the keyboard is based on the closest phonetic equivalent, where possible.

The "Muskego" and "Hang Up" fonts produce character shapes with no white space between them. The "<" and ">" characters are used to begin and end the pattern, as shown in the print samples.

The two "Harlow" fonts are essentially the same font, with the exception of the set type. They each contain the same upper case letters, but are both provided to allow all of the possible characters to be typed within the font memory limitations of CoCo MAX.

SPECIAL NOTES

The "Music" font can be used to create single part music notation directly from the keyboard. Each of the four rows of keys produce whole, half, quarter, and eighth notes at different positions on the staff. The punctuation keys on the top row produce the various rests, repeat and measure bars, the treble clef, and other notation symbols.

The "Banner" font produces character shapes with no white space between them. The "<" and ">" characters are used to begin and end the pattern, as shown in the print samples.
