User's Reference Card

Using MACRO keys

To use the MACRO keys, you need to
hold down the ALT key while pressing
any letter or number on the keyboard.
Letters have separate SHIFTED and
UNSHIFTED meanings, and because of
HARDWARE limitations, some keys will
not properly display their ALT + SHIFT +
"Key" combination. For these you must
be in SHIFT-LOCK (all caps mode).

Control Characters

Control Characters are ASCII values
less than 27 and correspond to any
letter of the alphabet by its position.
For instance A=1, B=2, C=3, etc.
Hold down CTRL and press the
UNSHIFTED letter you wish to use.

International Characters

International characters are a new
feature of the CoCo III which is very
seldom supported. To use them, hold
CTRL plus the indicated key, below. All
letters are CAPITALS.

Function Keys F1 & F2

Revelation! defines the function keys
to perform certain functions. F1 is
now used to toggle the processor
speed between 1 & 2 mhz (approx.)
Disk access now operates in the high
speed mode. Shift-F1 toggles the
status display ON and OFF (described
in detail in the disk documentation).
F2 now acts as SHIFT-O, making it a
CAPS-LOCK key.

General Keyboard Changes

The CLEAR key has been flipped. Now
CLEAR yields a backslash and SHIFT-
CLEAR blanks the screen.
ESC (ascii 27) has also been added to
SHIFT-BREAK.
