Incorporate as many as needed into your artwork. One way is to draw control buttons like the one I've used for FINISH. Use paint, felt nibs or collage to create designs from preliminary drawings. The materials and style are up to you!





INSTRUCTIONS

This pack enables you to create interactive pages. Each page has eleven usable switches. Switch I2 is programmed to return control to the computer keyboard. On pressing an Electronic Book switch the stored language will appear on the screen.



To load the program type CLOAD "DIY" and press ENTER on the keyboard. Press PLAY on the recorder. When loading is complete type RUN and press ENTER. Keep the PLAY button depressed until titles appear and then press STOP.

To load the program type CHAIN"DIY" and press RETURN on the keyboard. Depress PLAY on the recorder.

MENU After the titles and music you have 3 options.

Change or View Language.
 Save or Load Language.

3. Begin the Program.

OPTION I This will display the language stored for Page I Switch I.

F - Forward through switches & pages.

Range is Page I Switch I
B - Back through switches and pages.

to Page 6 Switch II

C - You can change the language for the current page and switch.

E - Exits to the MENU.

OPTION 2 You can Save or Load language. All data is saved and loaded i.e. from Page I Switch I through to Page 6 Switch II.

OPTION 3 Allows use of the Electronic Book. You select I - 6 from the computer keyboard. Switch I2 exits to MENU.

TANDY

Shift & Ø pressed together allows use of lower case letters.

For I6K machines keep the information fairly brief on each switch to avoid an OM error (out of memory).

OPTION I V - Allows you to see the language in PMODE4.

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BBC

'CAPS LOCK' light off allows lower case letters to be stored.
