



■ MAPPING SKILLS


To avoid getting lost while exporing our vast Solar System players will need to map their progress, taking note of landmarks along the way.




■ PLANETARY SCIENCE

Mickey and Pluto will need your assistance to figure out how to pilot the alien spaceship. Talk to the on-board computer to discover the order in which you must visit the planets in your treasure hunt. Then decipher the coded map of the solar system to figure out how to get there.



From our own Earth you'll visit each of the other eight planets. You'll stand on the scorched and rugged surface of Mercury, where temperatures can go up to 800° F.



You'll explore Mars, nicknamed the "red" planet because of its color, which is caused by large amounts of iron minerals in the ground.



You'll visit Jupiter, the largest planet in our Solar System, almost 1,400 times the size of Earth. You'll also visit Saturn, with its thousands of rings of ice and rock.



Of course, Pluto most wants to visit the planet he is named after. Pluto has the largest rotation of any of the nine planets averaging over 3 1/2 billion miles from the Sun!



When you complete your quest, you can bask in the knowledge of a job well done, then start the game all over again. The puzzles change each time you play Mickey's Space Adventure, so you can play it over and over and not play the same game twice.
