Loading the game

To start your battle, place the disk in drive 0 and close the door. Now type in

RUN"*" <enter key>

After a few seconds the disk drive will stop and the title screen displayed. At this point you may remove the disk from the drive for safe keeping.

Title Screen

While the title screen is displayed, magic snake music will play. Once the song is done the program will run a short demo. To end the demo early, press any key of the keyboard.

Once a key or joystick button has been pressed, the program will ask for the number of players. Press the "1" key for one player or "2" for two players at once.

The left joystick will control the left (Cyan) snake of player one. If there are two players then the right joystick will control the right (magenta) snake of player two.

The orange snakes are controlled by the evil demons.

Next the computer will ask for the skill level you wish to start off the game. Level 1 is by far the easiest with level 9 beyond most players!

Controlling Your Snake

Once the battle begins, the snakes will start moving down the screen. The snake can not stop or reverse, only turn. Move your joystick in the same direction that you wish the snake to turn.

You will note there are one to four demon snake eggs at the center of the screen. In a few seconds they will hatch with long orange snakes growing out of them.

Do not run into any snakes (even your own body) or the walls, this will end the run round for you. To kill off the demon snakes, use your own snake to encircle or block their path.

As the demon snakes slither around the pit they will drop more evil eggs. You may eat the eggs there by killing off the snake before it becomes a danger. The demon egg will flash just before it hatches.

Once all the demon snakes die off, then game will proceed with the next round with a higher skill level.
