LIMITED WARRANTY

I. CUSTOMER OBLIGATIONS

- A. CUSTOMER assumes full responsibility that this Radio Shack computer hardware purchased (the "Equipment"), and any copies of Radio Shack software included with the Equipment or licensed separately (the "Software") meets the specifications, capacity, capabilities, versatility, and other requirements of CUSTOMER.
- B. CUSTOMER assumes full responsibility for the condition and effectiveness of the operating environment in which the Equipment and Software are to function, and for its installation.

II. RADIO SHACK LIMITED WARRANTIES AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

- A. For a period of ninety (90) calendar days from the date of the Radio Shack sales document received upon purchase of the Equipment, RADIO SHACK warrants to the original CUSTOMER that the Equipment and the medium upon which the Software is stored is free from manufacturing defects. THIS WARRANTY IS ONLY APPLICABLE TO PURCHASES OF RADIO SHACK EQUIPMENT BY THE ORIGINAL CUSTOMER FROM RADIO SHACK COMPANY-OWNED COMPUTER CENTERS, RETAIL STORES AND FROM RADIO SHACK FRANCHISEES AND DEALERS AT ITS AUTHORIZED LOCATION. The warranty is void if the Equipment's case or cabinet has been opened, or if the Equipment or Software has been subjected to improper or abnormal use. If a manufacturing defect is discovered during the stated warranty period, the defective Equipment must be returned to a Radio Shack Computer Center, a Radio Shack retail store, participating Radio Shack franchisee or Radio Shack dealer for repair, along with a copy of the sales document or lease agreement. The original CUSTOMER'S sole and exclusive remedy in the event of a defect is limited to the correction of the defect by repair, replacement, or refund of the purchase price, at RADIO SHACK'S election and sole expense. RADIO SHACK has no obligation to replace or repair expendable items.
- B. RADIO SHACK makes no warranty as to the design, capability, capacity, or suitability for use of the Software, except as provided in this paragraph. Software is licensed on an "AS IS" basis, without warranty. The original CUSTOMER'S exclusive remedy, in the event of a Software manufacturing defect, is its repair or replacement within thirty (30) calendar days of the date of the Radio Shack sales document received upon license of the Software. The defective Software shall be returned to a Radio Shack Computer Center, a Radio Shack retail store, participating Radio Shack franchisee or Radio Shack dealer along with the sales document.
- C. Except as provided herein no employee, agent, franchisee, dealer or other person is authorized to give any warranties of any nature on behalf of RADIO SHACK.
- Except as provided herein, RAOIO SHACK MAKES NO WARRANTIES, INCLUDING WARRANTIES
 OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.
- E. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitation(s) may not apply to CUSTOMER.

III. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

A. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED HEREIN, RADIO SHACK SHALL HAVE NO LIABILITY OR RESPONSIBILITY TO CUSTOMER OR ANY OTHER PERSON OR ENTITY WITH RESPECT TO ANY LIABILITY, LOSS OR DAMAGE CAUSED OR ALLEGED TO BE CAUSED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY BY "EQUIPMENT" OR "SOFTWARE" SOLD, LEASED, LICENSED OR FURNISHED BY RADIO SHACK, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ANY INTERRUPTION OF SERVICE, LOSS OF BUSINESS OR ANTICIPATORY PROFITS OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES RESULTING FROM THE USE OR OPERATION OF THE "EQUIPMENT" OR "SOFTWARE". IN NO EVENT SHALL RADIO SHACK BE LIABLE FOR LOSS OF PROFITS, OR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF ANY BREACH OF THIS WARRANTY OR IN ANY MANNER ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED WITH THE SALE, LEASE, LICENSE, USE OR ANTICIPATED USE OF THE "EQUIPMENT" OR "SOFTWARE".

NOTWITHSTANDING THE ABOVE LIMITATIONS AND WARRANTIES, RADIO SHACK'S LIABILITY HEREUNDER FOR DAMAGES INCURRED BY CUSTOMER OR OTHERS SHALL NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT PAID BY CUSTOMER FOR THE PARTICULAR "EQUIPMENT" OR "SOFTWARE" INVOLVED.

- B. RADIO SHACK shall not be liable for any damages caused by delay in delivering or furnishing Equipment and/or Software.
- C. No action arising out of any claimed breach of this Warranty or transactions under this Warranty may be brought more than two (2) years after the cause of action has accrued or more than four (4) years after the date of the Radio Shack sales document for the Equipment or Software, whichever first occurs.
- D. Some states do not allow the limitation or exclusion of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation(s) or exclusion(s) may not apply to CUSTOMER.

IV. RADIO SHACK SOFTWARE LICENSE

RADIO SHACK grants to CUSTOMER a non-exclusive, paid-up license to use the RADIO SHACK Software on **one** computer, subject to the following provisions:

- A. Except as otherwise provided in this Software License, applicable copyright laws shall apply to the Software.
- B. Title to the medium on which the Software is recorded (cassette and/or diskette) or stored (ROM) is transferred to CUSTOMER, but not title to the Software.
- C. CUSTOMER may use Software on one host computer and access that Software through one or more terminals if the Software permits this function.
- D. CUSTOMER shall not use, make, manufacture, or reproduce copies of Software except for use on one computer and as is specifically provided in this Software License. Customer is expressly prohibited from disassembling the Software.
- E. CUSTOMER is permitted to make additional copies of the Software only for backup or archival purposes or if additional copies are required in the operation of one computer with the Software. but only to the extent the Software allows a backup copy to be made. However, for TRSDOS Software, CUSTOMER is permitted to make a limited number of additional copies for CUSTOMER'S own use.
- F. CUSTOMER may resell or distribute unmodified copies of the Software provided CUSTOMER has purchased one copy of the Software for each one sold or distributed. The provisions of this Software License shall also be applicable to third parties receiving copies of the Software from CUSTOMER.
- G. All copyright notices shall be retained on all copies of the Software.

V. APPLICABILITY OF WARRANTY

- A. The terms and conditions of this Warranty are applicable as between RADIO SHACK and CUSTOMER to either a sale of the Equipment and/or Software License to CUSTOMER or to a transaction whereby RADIO SHACK sells or conveys such Equipment to a third party for lease to CUSTOMER.
- B. The limitations of liability and Warranty provisions herein shall inure to the benefit of RADIO SHACK, the author, owner and/or licensor of the Software and any manufacturer of the Equipment sold by RADIO SHACK.

VI. STATE LAW RIGHTS

The warranties granted herein give the **original** CUSTOMER specific legal rights, and the **original** CUSTOMER may have other rights which vary from state to state.

TRSCOPY

Features

- * Transfers Disk BASIC text files to OS-9 disks
- * Transfers OS-9 text files to Disk BASIC disks

Package Contents

This package consists of an instruction manual and a disk containing the TRSCOPY program. TRSCOPY requires a Color Computer with the OS-9 operating system, 64K RAM, and one disk drive.

Before You Start

Before using TRSCOPY, you must transfer the program to an OS-9 operating system disk.

First, make a backup of your OS-9 system disk.

Single Drive Copy

With your OS-9 backup in the disk drive, type:

LOAD COPY ENTER

When the **OS9**: prompt appears, remove the OS-9 backup disk and insert TRSCOPY. Type:

COPY /D0/TRSCOPY /D0/CMDS/TRSCOPY -S #40K (ENTER)

When the screen displays:

READY DESTINATION, HIT C TO CONTINUE:

swap the TRSCOPY and OS-9 system disks and press C.

The screen displays:

READY SOURCE, HIT C TO CONTINUE:

Continue swapping disks according to the prompts until the **OS9:** prompt appears on the screen and signals that the copy is complete.

Delete the COPY program from memory by typing:

UNLINK COPY (ENTER)

and make a backup of the complete TRSCOPY/OS-9 disk.

Two-Drive Copy

Insert your OS-9 backup disk in Drive 0 and the TRSCOPY disk in Drive 1. Then type:

COPY /D1/TRSCOPY /D0/CMDS/TRSCOPY #40K ENTER

When the OS9: prompt appears, the copy is complete.

TRSCOPY

TRSCOPY is an OS-9 utility that lets you transfer text files between disks using Color Computer Disk BASIC and disks using the OS-9 operating system.

TRSCOPY transfers text files from either Disk BASIC to OS-9 or from OS-9 to Disk BASIC, but TRSCOPY runs only under the Color Computer's OS-9 operating system.

You may transfer both text files and programs saved as ASCII files from one operating system to the other. However, TRSCOPY moves files without modification; control and other special characters are copied, but not translated.

Note: Files created by Disk Basic are Type = BASIC Data File; ASCII Flag = TRUE.

TRSCOPY, like other OS-9 utilities, requires a command format of multiple commands on a single line. To transfer a file from Disk BASIC to OS-9, insert the TRSCOPY disk and type:

TRSCOPY filename/extension pathname ENTER

To transfer a file from OS-9 to Disk BASIC, type:

TRSCOPY pathname filename/extension **ENTER**

You must type both the spaces and the extension exactly as above.

The spaces (after **TRSCOPY** and the *extension* or *path-name*) serve as delimiters.

You must include the extensions on all Disk BASIC filenames because TRSCOPY "reads" the filename's embedded slash (/) as a signal that the file is a Disk BASIC file. This signal tells the program which operating system it is copying from and which it is copying to. Since OS-9 filenames don't have extensions, TRSCOPY reads any filename without an embedded slash (or with only a leading slash) as an OS-9 file.

In transfers from either direction, TRSCOPY copies the first file listed in the command line to the other operating system under the second filename.

Transfers with One Disk Drive

After you enter the command line, the computer prompts you for a series of disk swaps. (The size of the program being copied determines the number of swaps.)

If you transfer a file from Disk BASIC to the OS-9 operating system, the first prompt reads:

MOUNT DISK BASIC DISK -THEN PRESS <ENTER>

Insert the disk with the file you wish to transfer to OS-9 and press **ENTER**). The following prompt appears on the screen:

MOUNT OS9 DISK -THEN PRESS <ENTER>

The program then returns you to the OS-9 shell if the copy is complete; otherwise, it prompts you for additional disk swaps.

Note: Always be sure to insert the correct disk at each prompt. If you accidentally insert the wrong disk during

the first two swaps, TRSCOPY returns an error message. The program does this by checking the files as it opens them. After the files are open, however, TRSCOPY has no way of checking to make sure the proper disk is in the drive. Therefore, if you are transferring a large file on which TRSCOPY must make many passes, the program cannot warn you about incorrect disks after the the first two swaps. Always write protect your source disk before transferring files between operating systems.

The procedure for transferring files from OS-9 to the Disk BASIC operating system is the same. The prompts, however, are reversed:

MOUNT THE OS9 DISK -THEN PRESS <ENTER>

precedes

MOUNT THE DISK BASIC DISK -THEN PRESS <ENTER>

If the destination filename already exists or if the source file is not found, TRSCOPY aborts the transfer with no effect on either file system.

If a "Media Full", "Disk BASIC Disk is Full", or "Disk BASIC File List is Full" error message appears during a transfer, your program is either only partially copied or not copied at all. Make room on the disk by deleting unwanted files (including the partially copied file), or use another disk with enough free space to copy the file.

Transfers with Two Disk Drives

To use TRSCOPY with two or more disk drives, you must include the drive numbers of both files in the command line. For example, to transfer a Disk BASIC file in Drive 1 named TEXT/TXT to an OS-9 disk in Drive 0, insert the TRSCOPY disk in Drive 0 and type:

TRSCOPY TEXT/TXT:1 /D0/TEXT (ENTER)

When the **MOUNT DISK BASIC DISK** prompt appears, remove the TRSCOPY disk. Insert the TEXT/TXT disk in Drive 1 and the OS-9 disk you are copying to in Drive 0. Press (ENTER) to transfer the file.

Note: OS-9 and Disk BASIC use different formats to specify drive numbers. When you specify a drive in the TRSCOPY command line, you must use the correct format for each file's operating system. To copy a Disk BASIC file to or from a drive you must use a : drive #. To copy an OS-9 file to or from a drive you must use a / Ddrive #.
