

CocoDskUtil Setup

For the installation you must have an administrative account or administrative privileges.

For now: only in Windows Vista or Windows 7, you must disable the User Account Control (UAC).

In [Control Panel]-[User Account]-[Turn User Account Control on or off], Set off and Reboot.

After installation you could setting back the User Account Control, Set on and Reboot.

[Windows XP]: [Control Panel]- [Regional and Language options]-[Advanced Options Tab]-[Language for non-Unicode programs].

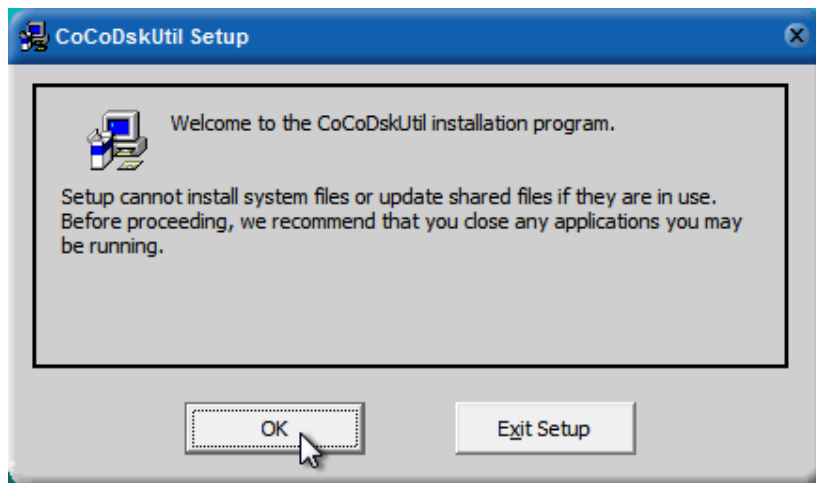
[Windows VISTA]: [Control Panel]- [Regional and Language options]-[Administrative Tab]-[Language for non-Unicode programs].

[Windows 7]: [Control Panel]- [Regional and Language options]-[Administrative Tab]-[Language for non-Unicode programs].

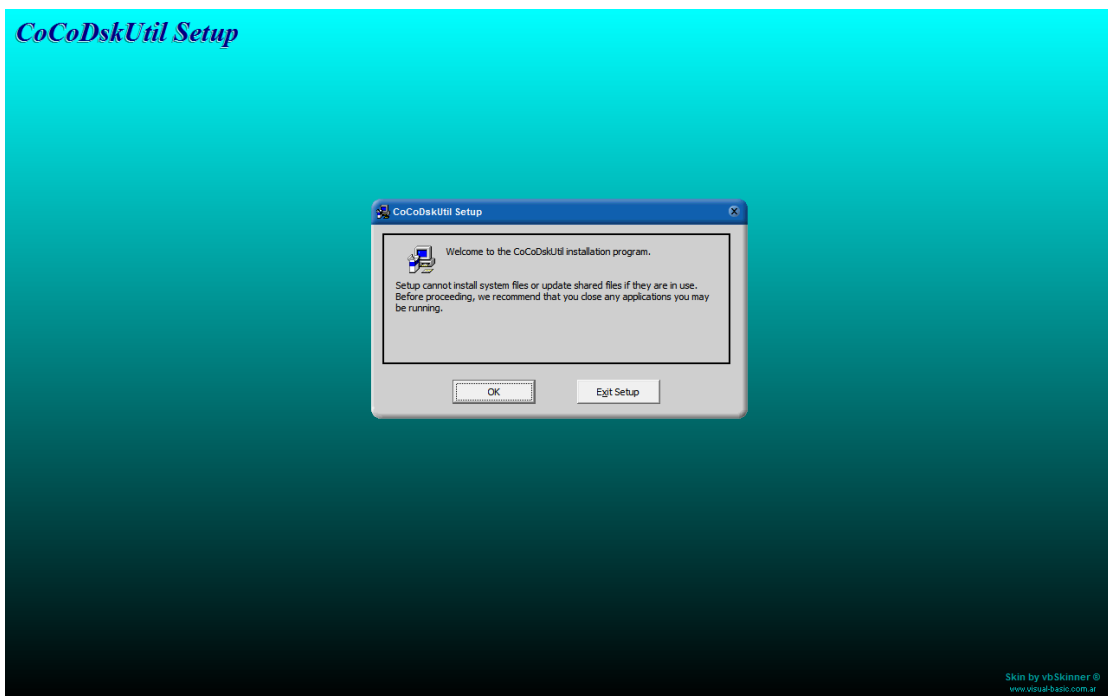
Even so, the first screen will be in Spanish, but the others will be in English



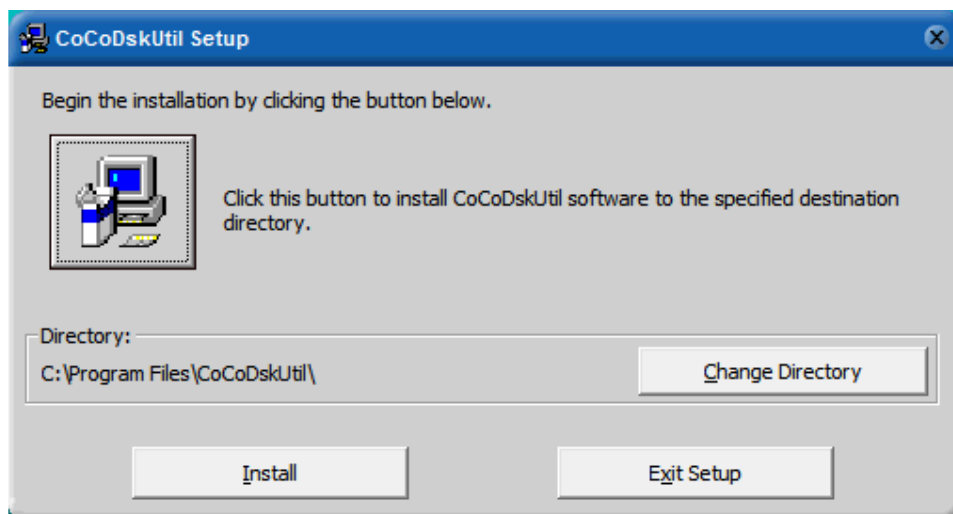

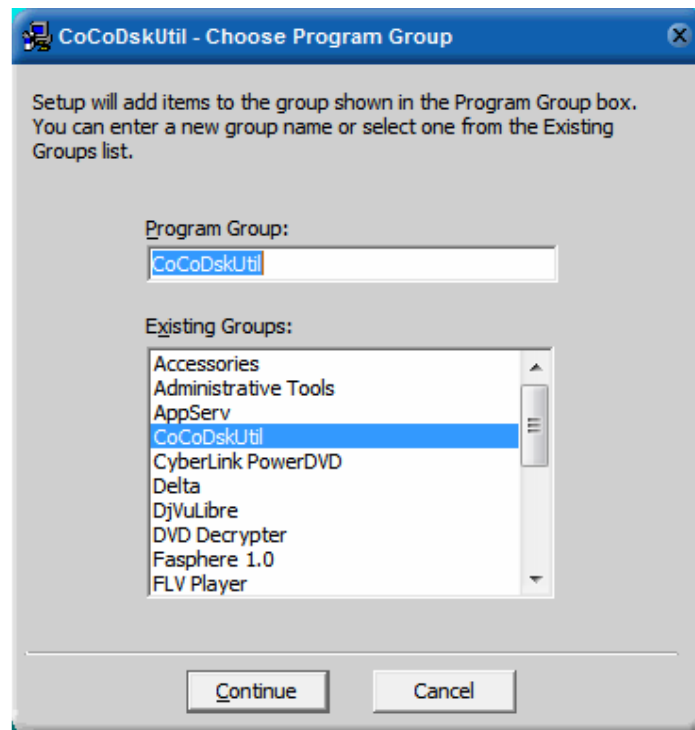

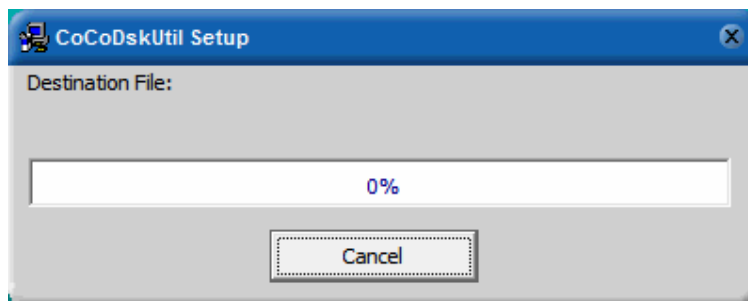
Select Install Or Setup Button, can also change the installation directory



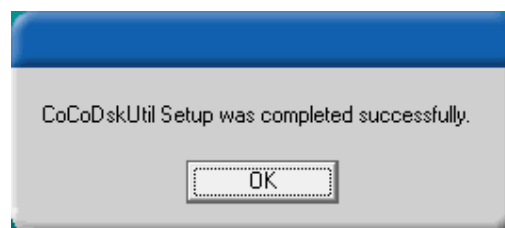

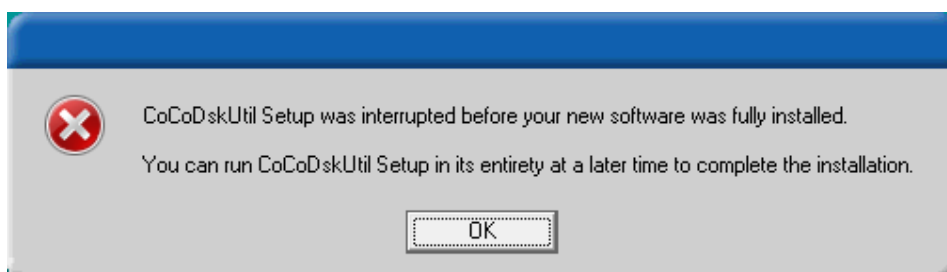

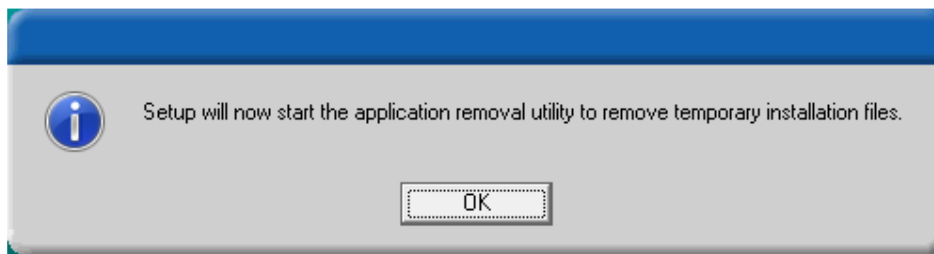
